TOPIC: *Bible Mathematics!*

TEXT: Matthew 28:11-20

INTRO: The Four Fundamentals of Mathematics!

I. SALVATION BEGINS WITH ADDITION: John 1:12 cf. Ephesians 3:17

Note: Salvation begins with addition when we ADD Christ into our lives the moment we receive Him by faith. It was by hearing that we have learned the facts of arithmetic, i.e., our teacher or perhaps our parents before we reached school age, told us that 1+1=2, and we believed it. By "faith" we accepted it as a fact!

*"Have you added the Lord Jesus into your life today?"

II. SALVATION CONTINUES WITH SUBTRACTION: Ephesians 4:25,31

Note: Salvation begins with addition when we add Christ into our lives by faith; then comes subtraction, as we are to SUBTRACT (or take away) from our lives all that are ungodly and displeasing before God. We have to "put off" and "get rid" of them! - Eph. 4:25, 31

1. "Put off" lying - Eph. 4:25
2. "Get rid" of hostile behavior - Eph. 4:31

Why Get Rid Of It?:

- A. Because it makes one a murderer -I John 3:14-15
- B. Because it grieves the Holy Spirit - Eph. 4:30-31

- Zacchaeus /Ephesian & Thessalonian Christians
- *"What has been subtracted, if any, from your life, since you got saved?"

III. SALVATION CONTINUES WITH MULTIPLICATION: Matt.28:19-20;John 1:40-49

Note: In Matthew 28:19-20, we are commanded to MULTIPLY, i.e., increase in number ("Go," "make disciples"); and in John 1:40-49, the process of multiplication is applied.

- Acts 1:8 Principle!

*"Have you multiplied, i.e., brought anyone to salvation

since you got saved?"

IV. SALVATION CONTINUES WITH DIVISION: Luke 12:51-53 cf. John 7:40-43

Note: Since Christ's identity (John 7:40-43) divides people, he therefore warns that the truth He proclaims would not always bring about peace, but rather, conflict and DIVISION - Matt. 10:34-36

- Muslims Getting Saved!

*"Do you continue serving God despite the fact people know that salvation is divisive?"

- The Foundation of Bible Mathematics!
